The cude-yellow weather warning was forgotten for a short time at the launch of the fourth Dublin Flamenco Festival, where guests could reimagine themselves as seductive, dramatic Andalusians dancing with aching hearts in the burning afternoon sun. Okay, not quite. And, curiously, this happened at Koh, the Asian restaurant.

The festival's codirector Nathalie Moyano Gonzalez – who describes herself as “French”, as she was born to Spanish parents who emigrated to the south of France during Franco's dictatorship – started flamenco dancing after she moved to Ireland, 13 years ago. Her fellow codirector Damien Power's love for Spain came from his love for guitar. Now the Waterford man-dances, too, at classes they run at Liffey Trust Dance Studios.

The flamenco guitarist Gato – who collaborated with Declan O'Rourke – is one of the festival's featured artists. Sherry plays a central role, too. Tinsely for December? Kind of, but not really. “Sherry in Ireland is a Christmas drink,” Power said. “In Spain you'd drink a dry sherry like this on a hot summer's day.”

The director of Dublin Dance Festival, Julia Carrothers, was “pretty pleased” with the previous day's announcement that three dance companies will have two weeks on the Abbey main stage during its festival next May. “And, to finish up, we'll have the flamenco bombot Iñaki Gabola, one of the world's incredible dancers.”
